

Charles Franklin Durham, (6 Feb 1866 – 20 Jan 1918), Harrisburg Telegraph, Harrisburg, PA, January 24, 1918: Trackwalker Killed

Newport, PA, Jan. 24. On his tenth day on duty, succeeding **H.W. Billow**, night trackwalker on the Pennsylvania Railroad, who was struck and instantly killed by a passenger train early this month, **Charles F. Durham**, 52, was struck and instantly killed on Monday morning. Funeral services were held on Wednesday with burial at Dellville. **Durham** is survived by a wife and three children.
