

**David A. Durham**, (11 Nov 1848 – 17 Nov 1933), The Chadron Journal, November 24, 1933

**David A. Durham** was born in Chester County, Pennsylvania, Nov. 11, 1848 and died in Chadron, Nebr. Nov. 17, 1933 at the age of 85 years 5 days. His childhood and youth were spent in Pennsylvania. He left that state at the age of 28 years and moved to Cherokee County, Iowa where he was united in marriage to **Allie Norman**, July 15, 1876. **Mrs. Durham's** death occurred in Casper, Wyoming, June 7, 1928. They were the parents of thirteen children, seven of whom are still living. From the state of Iowa, **Mr. Durham** moved to Nebraska in 1893. In 1912 they went to Wyoming where they settled on a homestead which was their home until the death of **Mrs. Durham**. Since then he has made his home with his three daughters, **Mrs. C. C. Drullinger** and **Mrs. Wm. Maiden** of Chardon, and **Mrs. T. J. Murnin** of Hot Springs, So. Dak. Besides the three daughters, he leaves four sons, **Charles Durham** of Indio, Calif.; **William Durham** of Interprise, Oregon; **John Durham** of Golden Dale, Wash.; and **Thomas Durham** of Seely, Wyoming. There are also thirty-one grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren. **Mr. Durham's** funeral was conducted from Erlewine Funeral Home Sunday afternoon, Nov. 19, by Rev. E. C. Newland. Interment in Greenwood cemetery.
