

John E. Eberly, (Died 21 Dec 1876), The Newport ledger, December 27, 1876

Eberly.-In is borough, one Thursday, December 21 inst., **Mr. John E. Eberly**, aged 29 years, 3 months, and 11 days'.

The deceased was born in Mechanicsburg, Pa., and was a son of **H. H. Eberly**, Esq, of that borough. When a mere boy he joined the Union Army. On his return he entered this office as an apprentice. After serving us faithfully, at the expiration of his apprenticeship we put him in charge of the office, where he remained until two weeks ago, when he was prostrated from the effects of a hemorrhage from the lungs. His disease made rapid progress and death soon relieved him from sufferings. He was a good printer, careful and attentive to business, a man of more than ordinary intelligence, strong in his convictions, warm in his attachment and faithful to his trusts. He leaves a widow and a little son and a little daughter to mourn the loss of a kind husband and affectionate of father.
