

Henry Clay Ebright, (20 Sep 1848 – 17 Oct 1919), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians, October 1919

Henry C. Ebright – From our Shermansdale Correspondent. On Friday morning at 1:30 o'clock at his home in Shermansdale, the soul of Mr. **Henry C. Ebright** passed peacefully to realms beyond. The deceased has been ill for the past three years and during the last week his condition was such that his death was expected at any time.

Mr. Ebright was born in Perry County and was 71 years of age. He is survived by his wife, three sons, and one daughter. For more than fifty years he has been a faithful member of Reiber's church and was ready and willing to go where the Lord hath called him. He was a most highly respected citizen and has a host of friends who will grieve to learn of his death and who deeply sympathize with the bereaved family in the loss of their kind husband and loving father. A noble life is ended, The family is grief-stricken and we can only say that it was the decree of one who knows best.

Burial was made at 10 a.m. Tuesday morning at the Lutheran church at Pisgah. The services being conducted by his pastor, Rev. G.A. Heiss.
