

Harry D. Ellenberger, (Died 1938), Duncannon Record, Friday, January 28, 1938

Harry D. Ellenberger, of Marysville, a retired Pennsylvania Railroad telegrapher, died yesterday morning at a hospital less than forty-eight hours after the death of the wife of his son, **Paul L. Ellenberger** trust officer of the Capital Bank and Trust Company. **Mr. Ellenberger's** widow, **Mrs. Bertha Ellenberger**, was discharged from the Harrisburg Hospital yesterday afternoon. She had been suffering from complication of diseases. She was admitted to the hospital one day after her husband who was suffering from streptococci infection.

Mr. Ellenberger, who had worked for many years at DY tower, at the southern end of the Enola Yards, was retired during the Summer. He is survived by his **widow**, one son, **Paul L. Ellenberger**; one daughter, **Mrs. Harry M. Deckard** of Marysville; his father **Abraham J. Ellenberger**, only civil war veteran of Marysville; and these sisters; **Mrs. John Roush** and **Miss Mabel Ellenberger**; of Marysville; **Mrs. John Kennedy**, of Harrisburg, and **Mrs. C. L. Conklin**, of Lemoyne.

Funeral services for his daughter in-law, **Mrs. Paul Ellenberger** will be held at 2 o'clock. Services for **Harry D. Ellenberger**, will be held at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon at the home in Marysville, with the Rev. Ezra Parks of Mill Hall Methodist Episcopal Church, assisted by the Rev. Francis Geiger, pastor of Marysville Methodist Episcopal Church, officiating. Burial will be in Chestnut Grove Cemetery, Marysville.
