

**Robert E. Enck**, (3 Apr 1934 – 9 Jul 2009), Perry County Times, Thursday, July 23, 2009

**Robert E.** “Bob” **Enck**, 75, of Loysville died Thursday, July 9, 2009 at home.

He was born April 3, 1934 in Carlisle to the late **Carrell** and **Grace Enck**.

His father founded Enck’s Sunoco Service Station in Loysville in 1951. In 1954, Bob became a co-owner with his father in a career that lasted more than 50 years. After his father retired in 1990, he owned the service station until his son Barry became a co-owner. He also farmed for many years.

He was a 1953 graduate of Boiling Springs High School; a Marine Corps Reserve veteran, joining in 1954; a member of New Hope United Church of Christ, Landisburg, and Millerstown Moose 925; had a wonderful way with animals and as a young man raced horses; and enjoyed car races and was an avid fan of Mark Richard.

Surviving are his wife of 54 years, **Marie A. (Curlen) Enck**; four sons, **Barry** of Loysville, **Ken** of Altoona, **Dave** of Loysville and **Bob** of Alexandria, Va.; a sister, **Doris Enck Murray** of Carlisle; a sister-in-law, **Darlene Enck** of Loysville; nine grandchildren, **Christopher, T.J., Michele, Danny, Elizabeth, Charles, Danielle, Maxwell** and **Ella**; and two great-grandchildren, **Morgan** and **Camden**.

He was preceded in death by a brother, **Harold** “Sonny,” **Enck** and a granddaughter, **Jennifer Lynn Enck**.

Services were held July 14 in his church with the Rev. Joshua D. Craley and Tim Wheeler officiating. Burial was in Restland Cemetery, Loysville.
