

Calvin Etter, (Died 1 Feb 1917), Patriot, Friday, February 2, 1917; Heart Disease Is Fatal To **Mr. Etter** - Prominent Merchant and Grain Dealer Dies in Eighty-second – Funeral to Be Held on Monday

Funeral services for **Calvin Etter**, 81 years old, for many years a dealer in grain, feed, and proprietor of a grocery business, who died yesterday morning at his home, 251 Boas Street from heart trouble, will be held Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock, at the late residence, the Rev. W. S. Herman, pastor of Zion Lutheran Church, officiating. Interment will be made in the Harrisburg Cemetery.

Mr. Etter was one of the oldest business men in the city, having conducted a store since 1865. He was born in Newport in 1835.

He was married to **Miss Helen Marshall** in 1865. **Mrs. Etter** survives, besides two daughters, **Mrs. Harry S. Kelly**, this city, and **Mrs. E. G. Sheaffer**, Middlesboro, Ky.; also one son, **Ross**, and two grandchildren.
