We had not heard of the death of our old friend and subscriber, **Capt. H. H. Etter**, which our paper went to press last week. He died at Philadelphia on Sunday, 22d ult. He was a native of Elizabethtown, Lancaster County, Pa. He was the proprietor of the Perry Warm Springs many years ago and under his management this summer resort attained a wide-spread reputation. For many years he resided in Philadelphia. His remains were interred in the Harrisburg Cemetery. He was aged 76 years, 6 months.
