David Love Ewing, (22 Jan 1849 – 6 Apr 1925), Newspaper Clipping

A retired veteran of the Pennsy, died at 6:30 last evening at the home of his daughter, **Mrs. W.C. Miller** of 403 Cherry Avenue. He had been in poor health for a number of years and was aged 76 years.

Mr. Ewing was born in Perry County Jan. 22, 1849, and spent almost forty-five years in the Pennsy service, retiring at the age of 70. He was a machinist in the Juniata shops under Foreman Garrety, leaving the service, upon reaching the age limit, on Feb. 1, 1919. Mr. Ewing was a member of the White Cross lodge No. 354 Knights of Pythias, Chicalacamoose tribe, Improved Order of Red Men, and the Juniata Shop Floral association.

He was married Oct. 23, fifty-three years ago, to Miss **Jane Ellen Powell**, who survives together with two sons, **William J. Ewing** of this city and **Charles F. Ewing** of Chester, Pa.; one daughter, **Mrs. Miller**, at whose home he died. Two grandchildren and one great-grandchild also survive. Mr. Ewing was the last of a family of five children.
