## Jane (Kinnear) Ewing, (16 Jun 1818 – 3 Apr 1887) Unknown Source



Mrs. Jane Ewing died at the residence of David R. Miller, West Side, Sunday night, aged 75 years. The deceased was the widow of John M. Ewing, a prominent pioneer of this city. She was also the mother of the late Captain A. K. Ewing, for many years Deputy Postmaster, and then briefly, Postmaster, of this city.

Mrs. Ewing came to this city from Philadelphia, Penn., with her sister who afterwards became the wife of **George E. Adams**. Another sister (**Mary Ann**) was wife of the late **Robert Mehaffe** (Mehaffy), of Royal Center.

She was long a member of the First Presbyterian church, and while her health permitted was unusually faithful in her attendance upon public worship. The loss of her husband and children bore heavily upon

her, but of late years the burden of her affliction has been mercifully lightened. She was a good woman in the large sense of the term, and no one can doubt that "it is well with her." The funeral will take place this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, with services at the First Presbyterian church.
