

**William Ewing**, (19 Sep 1840 – 20 Mar 1915), Altoona Mirror, Thursday, March 25, 1915

**William Ewing**, died March 20 at his home in McVeytown, at the age of 74 years, 4 months and 1 day. Mr. Ewing was a veteran of the Civil war (PA Cavalry, 20th Regiment, Company E, PA Provisional Cavalry, 1st Regiment, Company C) and a resident of McVeytown for the past fifty years. He was highly esteemed by all who knew him. He was a member of the Methodist church and superintendent of the Sunday school for the past twenty-five years. He was a prominent Free Mason and the fraternity conducted a very impressive service at the grave.

He is survived by his wife (**Margaret Moran**) and three daughters: **Mrs. Carrie Davis** of Media, **Mrs. Lizzie Stralie** of McVeytown and **Miss Dora**, at home; also by one brother, **D. L. Ewing** of 513 Eighth Avenue, this city. The funeral, yesterday, was attended by a large concourse of friends and relatives of this city. The floral designs were large and beautiful.
