

**George W. Fenical**, (17 Feb 1873 – 17 Sep 1904), Patriot, September 19, 1904

**George W. Fenicle**, 1102 Wallace Street, a freight brakeman on the Middle division of the Pennsylvania Railroad, was instantly killed early Saturday morning at Grantville by falling from his train as it was moving rapidly.

**Fenical** had been walking over his train and had gotten within several cars of his engine when he was jolted to the ground. The wheels passed over his body and death was almost instantaneous. The body was brought to this city and placed in charge of an undertaker.

**Fenical** was about thirty years of age and was well known among the railroad men. He was with an Altoona crew when the fatality happened.

The body was sent to Marysville on Saturday afternoon, where the funeral will take place this afternoon. The interment will be made in the Marysville cemetery. He is survived by his wife and one child.
