

D. Wesley Fisher, (27 Feb 1877 – 8 May 1899), Newport News, May 9, 1899

D. Wesley Fisher, who had been a sufferer with stomach and throat trouble since last June, and whose illness was mentioned in these columns some months ago, died suddenly yesterday morning at 10 o'clock. Early last fall he went to Sterrett's Gap in the hope of benefitting his health, but gradually grew worse and returned home. Accompanied by his father he went to Philadelphia and consulted a physician there, but received no relief and returned home, lingering until death relieved him of his suffering. **Wesley** was a bright and industrious young man and was liked by all who knew him. He went to school at the Mifflintown academy during the summer term of 1896. He was aged 22 years, 2 months, 11 days. Funeral services will be held in the Bethany United Evangelical church on Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment in Chestnut Grove cemetery.
