

Faye (Haines) Fry, (13 Mar 1933 – 17 Jan 2012), Perry County Times, 2 February 2012

Faye Fry, 78, formerly of Carlisle, died Tuesday, Jan. 17, 2012 in Boise, Idaho.

She was born March 13, 1933, the fifth of 11 living children of **Lewis** and **Dollie Haines** of Newport.

Growing up, she played basketball for the Newport Buffalos.

She married **Frank Fry Jr.** on June 2, 1957 and moved to California for his job with the Forest Service. They lived in many towns in northern California, where their three daughters were born. The family moved to McCall, Idaho in 1969 where she was a stay-at-home mother until 1976, when she began volunteering at McCall-Donnelly Elementary School as recess and lunch watch and library helper. She took a job at the Shore Lodge working front desk in 1978.

She loved sports all her life, in recent years rooting for the Boise State Broncos, Pittsburgh Steelers and Philadelphia Phillies, and participated in local bowling leagues. She was an avid card player and knitter and a member of Beta Sigma Phi Sorority and spent many hours at McCall Senior Center.

She was the widow of **Frank Fry Jr.**, who died in 2011 and to whom she was married 53 years.

Surviving are three daughters, **Carole Boyer**, **Barbara Johnson** and **Joanne Jones**; three grandchildren, **Sara Boyer** and **Ethan** and **Seth Johnson**; two sisters, **Mildred Dobyms** and **Vera Asper**; seven brothers, **Ralph**, **Carl**, **Ray**, **Lenus**, **Donald**, **Marlin** and **Grover Haines**; and many nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by a grandson, **Brett Boyer**, who died in 1991, and a brother, **Stanley Haines**.

A graveside service was held Feb. 1 in Bloomfield Cemetery.
