

John Frederick Fry, (Died 1 Jun 1935), Duncannon Record, Thursday, June 6, 1935

John Frederick Fry, aged 57 years, died at his home at Alinda, Saturday morning.

Deceased was a son of the late **Albert** and **Elizabeth (Roth) Fry**, and was born and reared in Perry County. He was a miller and carpenter and owned the mill that had been in the family for many years and where the greater part of his life had been spent. He also operated a cider mill and a sawmill.

He was an active member of the Landisburg Reformed Church, a teacher in the Sunday school and a member of the patriotic Older Sons of American and at the time of his death was district president, in addition to his widow he is survived by the following children; **Harry Fry**, of Carlisle; **Fred Fry**, Duncannon; **David Fry**, at home; **Mrs. Glenn Edwards** of Middletown, Conn.; **Mrs. George Zugg**, of Mt. Holly. The following brothers and sisters also survive: **Mrs. Calvin Cromleigh**, Duncannon; **Charles Fry**, **Mrs. Harry Lebo** and **Wilbur Fry** of Carlisle.

Funeral services were held at his late home Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. George Albright, of Rutherford Heights, officiating, assisted by Rev. J. J. Jones, pastor of the Landisburg Reformed Church, interment was made in the Carlisle Cemetery.
