

**Catherine (Howe) Fulton** (1824 – Oct 1898) Newport News, October 13, 1898,

Mrs. **Catherine Fulton**, the highly respected mother of **E.T. Fulton**, died about 9 o'clock, Monday night at the residence of her son, in East Newport. Her death was due to the infirmities of age and the effects of a paralytic stroke sustained 18 months ago.

She was a daughter of the late **William Howe** and was born in Howe Township (then Oliver) about 74 years ago. Her husband, who was **Thompson Fulton**, died in 1862. Her only surviving offspring is **E.T. Fulton**.

Her surviving brothers and sisters are: **Mrs. Susanna Hummes** of Harrisburg; **Abram Howe**, of Montgomery's Ferry; **Jerome Howe**, of Bradford, Pa.; Harrison Howe, of Oil City, and **Mrs. James F. Wilson**, of this place.

The funeral was held at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon, at her late residence, Rev. F. Adams officiating, interment was in the Newport cemetery. She was a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church for about 50 years.
