

Margaret (McKeehan) Gantt, Patriot, Tuesday March 17, 1914. Woman Dies at New Bloomfield

New Bloomfield, March 16 – Mrs. **Margaret Gantt**, of Centre Township, died on Saturday, of pneumonia, at the home of her son, **John M. Gantt**. Her maiden name was **McKeehan**, and she was the widow of **Isaiah Gantt**. She was for many years a prominent member of the Reformed Church of this place. She is survived by the following children: **Frank H. Gantt**, of Newport; **Harry L.**, of Chicago; **John M.**, of Newport; **Charles M.** of Downington; **Mrs. Bertie Nickerson**, of Chicago.
