

Ralph E. Garlin, (25 Nov 1916 – 31 May 2010), Perry County Times, Thursday, June 10, 2010

Ralph E. “Punk” Garlin, 93, formerly of Elliottsburg and Mt. Holly Springs, died Monday, May 31, 2010 in Manor Care of Carlisle.

He was born Nov. 25, 1916 in Elliottsburg to **Edward** and **Sara Rheam Garlin**.

He and his wife owned and operated a grocery store and delivered ice in Elliottsburg, was retired from Cumberland County Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, Carlisle, and was caretaker of Open Door Church, Carlisle, until its closing in 2007; attended Center Union God’s Missionary Church, Newport, before moving to Cumberland County, and attended Calvary Temple Holiness Church, Carlisle; and enjoyed re-upholstering furniture.

Surviving are wife of 69 years, **Mildred M. Plank Garlin**, and a son, **Robert E. Garlin**, both of Dillsburg.

Services were held June 3 in Hollinger Funeral Home and Crematory, Mt. Holly Springs, with the Rev. Clarence E. Dupert officiating.

Burial was in Bloomfield Cemetery.
