

Ruth L. (Park) Heaster Garlock, (7 May 1919 – 7 May 1990), Newspaper Clipping, May 16, 1990, The Perry Historians

Ruth L. Heaster Garlock, 71, of Mount Savage, Md., formerly of Mount Union, died at 7:45 a.m. Monday, May 7, 1990, at Sacred Heart Hospital, Cumberland, Md., after a lengthy illness.

Funeral services were held May 10, in Hyndman. The Rev. Thomas E. Young Jr., officiated. Interment was made in Restlawn Memorial Gardens, LaValle, Md.

Born in Saltillo on May 7, 1919, she was the daughter of the late **Edgar** and **Viola (Hazzard) Park**. She was twice married: first to **William C. Heaster**, then to **Elmer S. Garlock**, both of whom preceded her in death.

Surviving are two sons, **William D. Heaster** of Tobyhanna and **Jason M. Garlock**, Corriganville, Md.; two daughters, **Rachel N. Edgin** of Mount Union and **Sandra K. Ensminger**, Corriganville, Md.; two step-daughters, **Vicki L. Clower** of Romney, W. Va., and **Betty Jo Meyers**, Norristown; 11 grandchildren; three step-grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

Also surviving are four sisters; **Naomi Skipper**, St. Petersburg, Fla.; **Lena Rosenberry**, Mount Union; **Glendaline Aurant**, McVeytown; and **Mrs. Daryl Valentine**, Newton Hamilton.

A son, a daughter, a granddaughter, and a brother preceded her in death.

Mrs. Garlock was a member of Mount Savage United Methodist Church. She was also a member of the Auxiliary to Barrelville Outdoor Club.

She was a retired employee of the Allegany County (Md.) Board of Education, for whom she had worked as a cafeteria cook at Mount Savage High School. She was formerly employed in Mount Union, and at Harbison-Walker Refractories.
