

**Louis F. Gintzer**, (10 Nov 1838 - 10 Feb 1904), Patriot, February 12, 1904; Prominent Merchant Dead

Duncannon, Feb. 11. – The death of **Louis F. Gintzer**, a prominent dry goods merchant, at 10.30 o'clock today was a shock to the community. Although not in the best of health **Mr. Gintzer** was not ill and was in his store during the morning. Neuralgia of the heart was the immediate cause of his death. He is the fourth old citizen of the borough to pass away since January 1, and the third businessman.

**Mr. Gintzer** was aged 65 years and has a son in Chicago and one in Newport. He also leaves a widow. He was prominent in politics and at the time of death was a member of the borough council. He was also a veteran of the Civil War and was a member of Lieutenant William Allison Post, No. 196, G.A. R. He was also a member of the United Brethren Church whose pastor will conduct the funeral services, for which the arrangements have not yet been made.
