Enola Civil War Veteran in Dead. Enola, Oct. 6. – Funeral services will be held Monday afternoon at 1.30 o'clock in the Duncannon Church of God for **Edgar Grabill**, aged 79, who died yesterday at his home, 237 Dauphin Street. The Rev. J. J. Forncrook, of the Maclay Street Church of God Harrisburg, will officiate assisted by the Rev. S. F. Peters of the Duncannon Church of God. Burial will be made in the Duncannon Cemetery.

Mr. Grabill is survived by his wife **Mrs. Louise Jane Grabill**, sons **Anson F.**, of Chicago; **William M.** of Kennett Square, and **Harry C.** of Springfield, Ill.; daughters **Mrs. N. L. Kapp**, of Enola, and **Mrs. Olive Gilbert**, of Quarryville. One brother, **Charles**, of Coatesville, 16 grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

He was a retired iron worker and a veteran of the Civil War, being a member of the Duncannon G.A.R. Post. He was a charter member of the Duncannon Church of God
