

J. Mack Gray, (Died 15 Feb 1943), Duncannon Record, Thursday, February 18, 1943

J. Mack Gray, aged 69 years, 4 days, a prominent and widely known farmer, died at his home in Landisburg on Monday morning, of paralysis with which he was strick about, 11 o'clock Friday evening. He was a son of ex-sheriff **James A.** and **Anna E. Snyder Gray** and, was born at Elliottsburg. He was married to **Miss Annie Kistler**, of Elliottsburg, who died about forty years ago. He later married **Miss Emma Jones**, of Landisburg, who survives.

A daughter, **Laura, Mrs. Roy Spotts**, of Alinda; two sons, **James Gray**, Lock Haven, and **Edward Gray**, York; five grandchildren; a brother, **Clayton Gray**, New Cumberland, and a sister, **Mrs. Harry Wilson, Sr.**, of Loysville, also survive.

Mr. Gray was a member of Lutheran Church of Elliottsburg, and a former teacher in the Sunday School.

Funeral services were held this afternoon in the Elliottsburg Church, at 2:30 p.m., his pastor, Rev. J. Grayer C. Knipple, officiating, and burial was made in the Lutheran Cemetery adjoining the church.
