#### Boy's Death Follows Eating Of Tea Berries

Blain, Sept. 15 -- Funeral services for **George Gutshall**, 12 year old son of **Mr.** and **Mrs. William G. Gutshall**, of near Andersonburg, who died on Friday evening, were held this afternoon with burial in Blain, the Rev. G. R. Heim officiating. Young **Gutshall** is survived by his parents and one sister **Anna Gutshall**.

The boy's death is said to have been caused by heart trouble. Sunday a week ago he and a boy named **Foose** were in the mountains bringing in sheep. They both became very ill after eating some mountain tea berries which they had picked along their route. Young **Gutshall** then injured his knee in climbing a fence, rheumatism following the mishap. This and the illness from eating the berries are said to have resulted in a weak heart, causing the boy's death.
