

Mrs. Augusta (Geibel) Hartzell, Patriot Wednesday, April 7, 1909. Death of Miss Augustus Hartzell.

Mrs. Augusta Hartzell, of Newport, widow of the late **Colonel John Hartzell**, died yesterday morning after a brief illness, at the home of her daughter-in-law, Mrs. **Martha Hartzell**, 150 ½ North Sixth Street, this city. Brief funeral services will be conducted at 150 ½ North Sixth Street this afternoon at half past two o'clock by the Rev. S. B. Evans, the pastor of Ridge Avenue Methodist Church.

The body will be taken to Newport on way passenger Thursday morning, where services will be conducted at her late home at half past two o'clock by her pastor, the Rev. J. V. Adams, of the Newport Methodist Church.

Mrs. Hartzell is survived by four sons and one daughter: **W. E. Hartzell** and **Rev. C. V. Hartzell** of this city; **J. B. Hartzell**, of Altoona; **J. G. Hartzell**, of Newport, and Miss **Ada M. C. Hartzell**, of Providence R. I. Mrs. Hartzell was a daughter of the late **George L. Geibel** of Newport.

She was born in Germany, emigrating to this country when quite young. She was born May 2, 1827. She had a large circle of friends and acquaintances in this city.
