

Catherine (Reutter) Hawley, (1860 – 7 Dec 1912), The Perry County Democrat, Wednesday, December 11, 1912

DUNCANNON, Dec. 10th, 1912; **Mrs. Catherine Hawley**, wife of **Joseph C. Hawley**, died very suddenly on Saturday evening, from a stroke of apoplexy. Mrs. Hawley appeared to be in the best of health. She attended to her household duties as usual and also assisted in receiving of donations for the Harrisburg Hospital. She has just returned home from the town hall, and was telling her husband of the success of the committee in regard to the donations, when she was suddenly stricken and died before help could be summoned.

Mrs. Hawley was a daughter of the late **Dr. George N. Reutter**, Ex-Member of Assembly, of Watts Township. She is survived by her husband and two daughters, **Grace (Mrs. B. Stiles Duncan)** of Duncannon; and **Miss Catherine**, at home; also by two brothers, **Dr. H.D. Reutter** and **Thomas Reutter** and two sisters, Misses **Minnie** and **Carrie Reutter**, all of Duncannon.

Mrs. Hawley was a woman of beautiful character, devoted to her family and home. Her bright and cheerful nature, her kindness of heart and her fine social qualities all combined to win for her the respect, affection and admiration of all who know her. Her death is a sad blow for her family, who has the sincere sympathy of all.

She was a member of the Presbyterian Church and was an earnest worker in the church and Sunday school.

The funeral was on Tuesday afternoon, the services being conducted by her pastor, Rev Dr. G.H. Johnston; interment in the Presbyterian cemetery. The pallbearers were; **P.F. Duncan, James E. Wilson, William Wills, David Boyd, E.F. White,** and **Newton Brown.**
