

Samuel Heckard, (Died 27 Sep 1905), Patriot, Saturday, September 30, 1905; Died From Tetanus

As the result of tetanus, which was caused by a puncture of the foot by a rusty nail, **Samuel Heckard**, son of **William Heckard**, 1224 North Seventh Street, died on Wednesday afternoon at 4 o'clock.

About two weeks ago young **Heckard**, who is eight years of age, was playing in the school yard of the Downey building and tramped upon a nail, which penetrated his shoe. No attention was paid to the injury until Tuesday, and although a physician was called in the boy died in great agony.

The funeral service will be held this morning at 7.30 o'clock at the house by Rev. Leroy F. Baker, rector of the St. Paul's Episcopal Church. The remains will be taken to Millerstown tomorrow morning where the interment will be made.
