

H. Lizzie Hench (2 Apr 1850 – 5 Jan 1913), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

H. Lizzie Hench, age 62 years, died at her home near Elliottsburg Monday afternoon of this week from bronchial pneumonia. She had been in failing health for some years past with complications in which Bright's disease was prominent. She was taken ill Thursday of last week and her condition failed to improve under treatment.

The deceased was the daughter of the late **George B.** and **Rachel G. (Hackett) Hench** and was born in Elliottsburg, April 2, 1850, and at her death she was aged 62 years, 9 months 4 days.

Miss Hench in her early girlhood became a member of the Reformed Church and lived a consistent Christian life. Unmarried, she devoted her life to her parents and her sisters and brothers. She was unselfish and to make others happy seemed to be her mission.

She is survived by the following sisters and brothers; **Della U. Hench**, of Elliottsburg, **Ross H. Hench** of Harrisburg, **Martin M. Hench** of New Cumberland, **David B. Hench** of Elliottsburg, **Anna R. Hench** and **Mrs. S. H. Bernheisel** of this place.

Funeral services were held in the Reformed Church, Rev. J. Thomas Fox, of this place officiating, followed by interment in the family burial plot at Center.
