

Terry Lee Hench, (19 Jul 1938 – 17 Dec 2011), Perry County Times, 31 December 2011

Terry Lee Hench, 73, of Carlisle died due to an accident Saturday, Dec. 17, 2011 at M. S. Hershey Medical Center.

He was born July 19, 1938 in Carlisle to the late **Luther Elwood** and **Theetta Calaman Hench**.

He worked masonry, brick and block and carpentry jobs, including masonry with the late Jim Delancy and the former Raymond Shearer Contractors and Lynn Myers Construction, built homes with his dad, Elwood Hench, for many years, worked 15 years in the maintenance department of West Perry schools while living in Shermans Dale, Perry County, and after moving back to Carlisle he worked at Applied Industrial Technologies on Claremont Road as a maintenance/custodian until his retirement in 2003; and served in the National Guard's 104th Recon Squadron for six years.

Surviving are his wife of 49 years, **Beverly Hench** of Carlisle; two sons, **Chris J.** of Mechanicsburg and **Chad D.**, a special needs son living at home; and two grandchildren, **Cristin Hench** and **Nicholas Hench**, both of Mechanicsburg.
