

Calvin J. Henry, (1874 – 31 Mar 1909), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Hisotrians

Calvin Henry, age 35 years, son of **Daniel S. Henry** of Jackson Township, died at the home of his brother in-law, **Harry Seidel**, in Harrisburg, on the 31st from tuberculosis of the bowels, in his 35th year.

He had been engaged as a track hand on the Pennsylvania Rail Road at Newport and was injured somewhat, and had been ailing since October last with the disease that caused his death. Lately he had been under the treatment of a Harrisburg physician. A week prior to his death he went to Virginia he stated to purchase land, returning, he died the next day.

March 20, 1902 he was married to **Matilda C. Seidle** of Madison Township, who survives him with two children.

The remains of the deceased were brought to the residence of his father in-law, **Jacob Seidle**, at Bixler's Mills, on Friday, and interred at St. Paul's Church, Monday, Rev. J.C. Reighard officiating, assisted by Rev. David Roth.
