

Margaret (Grubb) Hetrick, (18 Aug 1823 – 13 Feb 1913), Unknown Source, Mrs. Margaret Hetrick is Dead at Winnebago.



Winnebago. Feb 14 -- Mrs. **Margaret Hetrick**, one of Winnebago's oldest residents passed away Thursday evening at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Nellie [**Millie**] **Birch**, after a month's illness. Mrs. Hetrick had been in failing health for some time and recently, when complications developed, she took to her bed. Her friends realized that on account of her advanced age she would not be able to rally and they watched her fall steadily until the end.

Mrs. Hetrick was born in Liverpool, Perry County, Pennsylvania, August 18, 1823, where she was united in marriage in 1848 to **Jacob Hetrick**. They remained in the east till 1857, when the family moved to Illinois, settling near Byron, which was their home until twenty years ago. At that time they moved to Westfield Corners, where they resided on a farm until the death of **Mr. Hetrick** in 1907. Since that time **Mrs. Hetrick** has made her home with her daughter, **Mrs. Birch**.

She leaves four daughters and four sons: **Mrs. Martha Mandeville**, Elida; **Mrs. [Millie] Birch**, **Mary Hetrick** and **Mrs. Harry Allen**, all of Winnebago; **Allen Hetrick**, Byron; **Adam Hetrick**, Geering, Neb.; **Clarence Hetrick**, of Alta, Neb.; **William Hetrick**, residing near Byron. There are also twelve grandchildren and one great grandchild.

The funeral will be held Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the home of her daughter, Mrs. Birch. Rev. Mr. Armstrong of Middle Creek church will officiate. Interment will be in the Middle Creek cemetery.
