

Ivan L. Hill, (1912 – 2 Mar 1993), Unknown Newspaper Source, 18 Jun 1993

Mt. Auburn – **Ivan L. Hill**, 81, Clearwater, FL, died March 2, 1993, at Mease Hospital in Dunedin, FL, of natural causes.

Mr. Hill had lived in Clearwater since moving there in 1977 from Chicago. He was a former professor emeritus and chairman of the engineer graphics department at the Illinois Institute of Technology in Chicago.

Mr. Hill was also a 20 year member of the Engineering Drawing Standards Committee of the American National Standards Institute; he also was listed in “Who’s Who In American Education.

He was a member of several professional societies and organizations and the First Presbyterian Church of Duniden.

Survivors include his wife, **Lucille**, Clearwater; a son, **David L. Hill** of Irvine, CA; three daughters, **Margaret Haeveran** of Clearwater, **Elaine Cisewski**, Washington Crossing, PA, and **Jane Beins** of Grand Island, NE; 11 grandchildren; four great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, **James** and **Lizzie Kaiser Hill** of Mt. Auburn; one sister **Erma Bradfield** of Oelwein, and a brother, **Edwin Hill** of Mt. Auburn.

Public graveside services will be Tuesday, June 22, at 11 a.m. at Evergreen Cemetery, Vinton. Arrangements by Campbell-Russell-Overton Funeral Home, Vinton.

Dr. Morey of the Vinton Presbyterian Church will officiate the graveside service, and a luncheon will be held following the graveside service at the Presbyterian Church.
