

Lucille Margaret (Johnson) Hill, (23 Aug 1917 – 21 Apr 2002), Unknown Newspaper Source, Vinton, Illinois

Vinton – Former Vinton resident **Lucille Margaret Hill**, 84, of Clearwater, Florida, died Sun., Apr 21, at Manor Care in Pal Harbor, Florida due to an extended illness.

Lucille was born on August 23, 1917, the daughter of **Clark L.** and **Nellie (Halpin) Johnson**. Her birth mother **Nellie** died when she was 14 months old. **Lucille** was raised by a loving and caring mother, **Leta (Rice) Johnson**. She attended country school and later graduated from Vinton High School in 1934.

Lucille continued her education at Iowa State University before her marriage to **Ivan L. Hill** on March 22, 1936, at the Little Brown Church in Nashua. They made their home in Ames and later moved to Grove City, PA, for four years. **Lucille** and **Ivan** then moved to Chicago where they lived for 37 years. They retired in 1973 and moved to Florida. **Ivan** passed away in 1993 and **Lucille** remained in Florida. More recently, she has been a resident of Manor Care in Palm Harbor, Florida.

While in Florida, **Lucille** was an active member of the First Presbyterian Church in Dunedin and was involved in TTT. She was a former member of Pratt Creek Church.

Lucille was preceded in death by her parents and husband. She is survived by her son **David (Myrna) Hill** of New Coast Beach, CA; three daughters, **Margaret Heveran** of Clearwater, **Elaine (Jerry) Ciszewski** of Washington, PA, and **Jane Beins** of Grand Island, NE; 11 grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.

Services will be held at 11, Sat., April 27, in Vinton at Overton-Van Steenhuyse Funeral Home, with Rev. Bill Berry officiating. There will be no visitation.

Burial will be at Evergreen Cemetery.
