**Mervin E. Hill**, 65, 427 Arch St., died Monday in Carlisle Hospital.

He was born in Shermansdale, Perry County and was the son of the late **William** and **Mary Miller Hill** and resided most of his life in Carlisle.

He was a member of the Carlisle Police Department for 35 years, retiring as a sergeant in 1973. After retirement he was employed as a dispatcher and clerk at the Carlisle Police station, retiring in 1981.
