

**William James Hill**, (28 May 1871 – 7 Sep 1921), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

**William Hill**, a well-known resident of Rye Township Perry County died very suddenly about two o'clock this morning. The cause of his death is unknown. A few minutes before he died he spoke to his wife, remarking on the heavy rain that was falling. She spoke to him again in a few minutes and getting no answer, discovered that he was dead.

A man interested in public education, having at heart the welfare of the rising generation. He served in the capacity of School Director in his township, faithfully and conscientiously discharging the duties revolving upon him.

A son of the late **Joseph** and **Elmina Hummel Hill** of Rye Township. His wife survives, **Mary Miller Hill**. Four sons, **Roy Hill**, **Paul Hill**, **Bruce Hill** and **Mervin Hill**. Brothers, **Charles Hill** and **George Hill**. Sisters **Elizabeth Hill** Baum of Carlisle Springs, **Ellen Hill** and **Lydia Hill Swinn** of Rye Township.
