John Hipple, Marysville, Pa., was born June 30, 1843, son of **George** and **Elizabeth (Bentzel) Hipple**. His father, **George Hipple**, was a farmer in Perry County. **George Hipple** was married to **Elizabeth Bentzel**. Two of their seven children are living: **Amanda** and **John**. **Mrs. Hipple** died about 1857; **Mr. Hipple**, November 11, 1872. **John Hipple** was educated in the public schools, and learned masonry, at which he worked for ten years, but has spent most of his life on the farm. **Mr. Hipple** is a Republican.

John Hipple was married December 8, 1874, to **Mary J. Freed**. Their children are: **Cora May**; **Arbie E.**; **Sadie E.**; **Nettie J.**; **Walter J.**; and **Richard B.** The family attend the Evangelical Church, of which **Mrs. Hipple** and two daughters are members.
