

**Mary J. Hipple**, (22 Jan 1847 – 16 Feb 1912), Patriot, Thursday, February 22, 1912, Death of **Mrs. Mary J. Hipple**, Well Known Marysville Woman Was Victim of Pneumonia

Marysville, Feb 21. – **Mrs. Mary J. Hipple**, widow of **John Hipple**, died at her home on Maple Avenue Friday evening after a brief illness of pneumonia. Mrs. Hipple was born in York County January 22, 1847, making her age at the time of death 65 years and 25 days. In early life she united with the United Evangelical Church of the Keystone charge, and six years ago she transferred her membership to the United Evangelical Church of Marysville and was a faithful member until death.

She is survived by three daughters, **Mrs. Simon Hess**, **Mrs. James E. White** and **Miss Nettie**, all of Marysville, and two sons, **Richard** and **Walter**. Funeral services were held at her late home Tuesday afternoon. Her pastor, the Rev. I. N. Bair, officiated, assisted by the Rev. George Albright, of Winfield and the Rev. Mr. Shue, of West Fairview. Interment was made in Chestnut Grove Cemetery, Marysville.
