**David R. Hockenberry**, 67, of Newville, died Friday, June 26, 2009, in Carlisle Regional Medical Center.

He was born March 13, 1942, in New Germantown to C. **Arlene (Burd) Hockenberry** of Newville and the late **Roy D. Hockenberry**.
