

Philip M. Hoffman, (Died 30 Apr 1920), Patriot, Monday, March 1, 1920

Philip M. Hoffman, aged 61 years, a prominent conductor of the Middle Division of the P. R. R., died yesterday after a brief illness.

Funeral services will be held at his late residence, 2335 North Sixth Street on Thursday morning at 11 o'clock, the Rev. Dr. Amos M. Stamets officiating. The remains will be taken to Newport the same day by Hoover and Sons for further services and burial.

Mr. Hoffman is survived by his wife, **Margaret**, and brother, **James Harvey**, of Minnesota, also sisters, **Mrs. W. H. Anderson**, and **Mrs. Julius Meyer**, of Minnesota, **Mrs. Margaret Muller**, of New Bloomfield, and **Mrs. Mahala Cook**, of this city. He was a member of the Loyal Order of Moose and Order of Railway Conductors, also Augsburg Lutheran Church.
