

Dr. W. H. Hoopes (26 Oct 1862 – 20 Feb 1918), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

Dr. W.H. Hoopes, one of Newport's leading physicians was thrown out of his sleigh Sunday about 11:30 a.m. at Ore Bank Hill, while on his way to visit a patient and his head striking a stone, causing concussion of the brain and a hemorrhage resulting. **Dr. Hoopes** after the accident walked to a house nearby and physicians were summoned from Newport, but he was unconscious before their arrival. He was taken home by Dr. Linus A. Carl and died at 4 p.m.

He was the son of the late **William and Mary Jane (Cooper) Hoopes** and was born at Port Royal, Juniata County. He graduated from the College of Physicians and Surgeons at Baltimore Md., in 1887. He practiced at McAllisterville and since 1893 had practiced in Newport. He was a consistent member of the Presbyterian Church and a ruling elder for 30 years.

December 29, 1887 he married Miss **Sadie E. Hesser**, of McVeytown, Pa. who survives without issue. **Frank J. Hoopes**, of Mulhall, OK, and Mrs. **Jas. B. Henry** of McCoyville are his brother and sister.

Interment was made at the Newport Cemetery.
