

Daniel E. Hoover (2 Jan 1915 – 29 Mar 2003) , Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

Daniel E. Hoover, 88, of Walnut Street, Newport, died Saturday, March 29, 2003 in Holy Spirit Hospital, Camp Hill.

He was born Jan. 2, 1915 in Sunbury to the late **William** and **Emma (Lontz) Hoover**.

He had worked for Fidelity and Trust Co., Philadelphia, and the former Newport Laundry and was owner of Hoover Insurance Agency, Newport; a Navy veteran of World War II; a member of Incarnation United Church of Christ, Newport, where he was a former choir member, Sunday school teacher and consistory member, Newport Lodge 381, F&AM, and Newport Royal Arch Chapter 238, where he was a past High Priest; secretary for the former Newport School District Authority; past member and president of Newport School Board and past member of Newport Water Authority; active in district Boy Scouting and former assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 222; and an avid reader.

He was the widower of **Francis Soule Hoover**.

Surviving are his wife, **Sara Gelnett Beaver Hoover**; a son, **Daniel S.** of Painted Post, N.Y.; two stepdaughters, **Ann L. Bowman** of Lancaster and **Kathryn J. Hostetler** of Ebensburg; a sister, **Ethel Metzler** of Milton; three grandchildren, **Pamela Burch** of Richmond, Va., **Daniel S. Hoover** of Chambersburg and **Kathleen Speicher** of Painted Post, N.Y.; six stepgrandchildren; six great-grandchildren; and two stepgreat-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a daughter, **Christine Hoover**.

Services were held April 3 in his church with the Rev. A.O. McGill officiating. Burial was in Newport Cemetery. Myers Funeral Home, Newport, handled arrangements.
