

Raymond L. Horting, (Died 25 Nov 2011), Patriot-News, Sunday, November 27, 2011

Raymond L. Horting 88, of Harrisburg, died Friday, November 25, 2011, at the Community General Osteopathic Hospital.

Mr. Horting was born in Newport and was the son of the late **Raymond** and **Verna Wieland Horting**. He was retired from the Penn Railroad, where he was a Mechanic. He was a veteran of WWII, serving with the U.S. Army. He was featured in the book, Thundering Thunderbolt, a story of the 790th Field Artillery Battalion, in which he served. He was a member of the Disabled American Veterans.
