

Jesse McKee Hostetter, (20 Sep 1869 – 20 Oct 1915), Perry County Times, Thursday, October 28, 1915, Former Perry Countian Dies in Fayette County

Jesse McKee Hostetter, principal of the South Connellsville, Fayette County public schools, was found sitting at his desk dead in his private office in the public school building of that place on Wednesday morning of last week. Heart failure caused his death. He was the son of **Abram** and **Mary (Hoffman) Hostetter**, and was born near Mannsville September 20, 1869. His wife, (nee) Anna M. Adams and the following children survive him; **Mrs. J.K. Wilson** and **Miss Matilda Hostetter**, Johnstown, and **Jesse Jr.**, and **Ruth** at home. He was an alumnus of Bloomsburg State Normal School and Lebanon Valley College, Annville, Susquehanna University, Selinsgrove, conferring upon him the degree of A.M. He taught in this county, and had been superintendent of the South Sharon schools and principal of the public schools of Danville, Girard, Ohio, and South Connellsville. He was a member of the Lutheran Church, Knights of Pythias, and F&AM, Danville. His body was interred in Chestnut Grove Cemetery, Marysville, Friday afternoon, following funeral services which were conducted in the Zion Lutheran church, Marysville, by the Pastor, Rev. S. L. Rice.
