Newport, PA - **Charles Irvin "Chuck" Howell**, 62, of Winding Hill Road, Newport, PA, entered into eternal rest on Friday evening, October 8, 2004 in The Holy Spirit Hospital, Camp Hill, PA, following a brief illness.

He was born in Oliver Township, Perry County, PA on March 30, 1942, the son of the late **Theodore L. and Margaret (Stroup) Howell**. On October 22, 1960, he was married to the former **Judy Willow**, who survives. His passing breaks a strong marital union of nearly 44 years.

Chuck graduated in 1960 from Greenwood High School, Millerstown, PA. He retired on disability from PennDOT (Traffic Unit) Harrisburg, PA in 1997 after 30 years employment as a traffic control technician.
