**Robert N. Ickes** of Wilmington, Del., a former Harrisburg radio announcer, died Friday in Brandywine Convalescent Nursing Home, Wilmington.

He was an announcer on WHP radio, known professionally as Bob Carlisle; an advertising and sales promotion executive with firms in Pennsylvania, Delaware and Florida; a writer and publisher of Republican newspapers; a public relations director for the Dauphin County Republican Committee and a speechwriter for Pennsylvania political candidates.

He was an Army veteran of World War II and a member of the Disabled American Veterans.

Surviving are a son, **Robert B., Jr.** of New Castle, Del., and two grandsons.

Services will be held at 1 p.m. Wednesday in the Neumyer Funeral Home with the Rev. Hubert J. Kealy officiating. Burial will be in East Harrisburg Cemetery.
