

Willis Jefferson Ickes, (9 Jan 1859 – 4 Oct 1938), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians;
W. J. Ickes Dies At Turbotville



Willis J. Ickes, well-known resident of Turbotville, died at the home of his daughter, **Mrs. John Moon**, at 4 o'clock this morning after an illness of several weeks. He suffered a stroke about two weeks ago.

Mr. Ickes was 80. He made his home with his daughter for the past 16 years. He was a former resident of Harrisburg, and was born in Perry County. He belonged to Newport Lodge No. 102, I.O.O.F. and Newport Council No. 614, Jr. O.U.A.M.

Surviving are four daughters: **Mrs. Moon**, with whom he resided; **Mrs. Lynn Clouser**, **Mrs. Edward Shearer** and **Mrs. Francis Leib** of Harrisburg; five grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon at 1 o'clock at the Paul S. Grittner funeral home in Turbotville, with the Rev. Carroll S. Rudisill, pastor of St. James Lutheran Church, Turbotville, in charge. Interment will be made in East Harrisburg Cemetery.
