Anna C. 'Gertie' Johnson, 81, formerly of South Front Street, Liverpool, died Saturday at the West Shore Health & Rehabilitation Center in Camp Hill.

She was a Millerstown high School graduate; the operator for many years of 'Johnson's Tourist Home,' housing construction workers working on the Routes 11 and 15 project; she was a member of the Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd in Liverpool, where she assisted with the summer Bible school and was a choir member; she was a member of the Liverpool Senior Citizens; and had a citizen band radio name of 'Flower Lady,' because of her love of flowers.

She was the widow of **Harold E. 'Sam' Johnson**. Surviving are a son, **Richard M.** of Newport; two daughters, **Suzanne Eckenrode** of Camp Hill and **Carol Gingrich** of Dallastown; a sister, **Virginia M. Books** of Newport; four granddaughters; and five great-grandchildren.
