

**Charles L. Johnson**, (Died 7 Mar 1937), Newspaper Clipping,, The Perry Historians

Duncannon, March 9 -- **Charles L. Johnson**, 70, Perry county sheriff many years ago, retired school teacher, farmer and horse dealer, died Sunday night of a heart attack in the Carlisle Hospital, five days after he had been removed from his New Bloomfield home to the institution.

He is survived by his widow, **Mrs. Mary Johnson**, and two brothers, **Jesse**, Duncannon, and **George**, Los Angeles. Funeral services will be held at 2:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon at the home, with the Rev. Donald Rhoads, pastor of the New Bloomfield Lutheran Church, officiating. Burial will be in the New Bloomfield Cemetery. The body may be viewed at the home tomorrow evening.

**Mr. Johnson** was born in Watts township, Perry County, the son of the late **Jesse** and **Elizabeth Shatto Johnson**.
