SHERMANS DALE - **Harry L. Jones**, 82, of Shermans Dale and Tuckahoe Acres, Delaware, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Tuesday, January 16, 2007 at home.

He was born May 19, 1924 in Shermans Dale, to the late **Louis** and **Olive (Baum) Jones**.

He was retired from Harrisburg State Hospital as a plumbing foreman, with 27 years of service and was a U.S. Navy Veteran of World War II, serving on the U.S.S. Croatan.
