

John Milton Jones (Died 2 Sep 1913), Newport News, September 11, 1913

John Milton Jones died at his home in West Newport on Friday at 10:10 p.m. of cancer of the stomach and liver, of which he had been suffering since March 27, 1913. He was born in Pfouts Valley April 9, 1853, and was a son of **Ezekiel** and **Catherine (Machamer) Jones**. He was married near Thompsontown to **Elizabeth Delilah Miller**. While in that neighborhood he followed boating and farming. Three children were born to this union, viz. **Mrs. Anna Belle Arnold** of Pfouts Valley, **Mrs. Minnie May Latchford** of this place and a son who died in infancy. **Mrs. Fannie Frank** of Harrisburg and **Mrs. Helen Geistwite** of Shamokin and **Albert Jones** of this place are his surviving sisters and brother. Short funeral services were held at his late home on Monday at 1 p.m. when the body was taken to Red Hill where services were held by Rev. J.C. Reeser of Lewistown and Rev. E. Fulemoer of this place.
