

Catherine V. (Hultzapple) Kauffman, (29 May 1919 – 27 Sep 2011), Patriot-News, Thursday, September 29, 2011

MIFFLINTOWN-**Catherine V. Kauffman**, 92, of Mifflintown, died at 8:25 a.m. Tuesday, September 27, 2011, at the Lewistown Hospital.

Born on May 29, 1919 in Newport, Perry County, she was a daughter of the late **Alfred and Maltilda (Leinaweaver) Hultzapple**. On November 27, 1947, she married her late husband, **Samuel G. "Sam" Kauffman**, with whom she spent more than 59 years of marriage, before he preceded her in death on December 10, 2006.

Surviving are her son, **Kurt S. Kauffman** and his wife **Beverly**, of Campbelltown, two grandchildren, **Nicholas Kauffman**, of Campbelltown, **Rebecca Thomas**, of Oviedo, FL, two great grandchildren, **Olivia Thomas** and **Kayley Thomas**.

She was the last of her immediate family having been preceded in death by three sisters, **Dorothy Castle**, **Martha Hamilton** and **Jean Squibb** and one brother, **Alfred Hultzapple**, who was killed in Italy during WWII.

Mrs. Kauffman was a 1937 graduate of Newport High School, and a 1939 graduate of Thompson Business College, Harrisburg. She was also a member of Grace United Methodist Church, Mexico, where she taught children's Sunday school classes, was the church pianist, served on the church council and was the financial secretary for a number of years.

She was employed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for 16 years and retired as a bookkeeper for Juniata Lumber and Supply Company, Mifflintown in 1984. Catherine enjoyed crocheting and doing crossword puzzles.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m., on Sunday, October 2, 2011 at the Brown Funeral Homes, Inc., 100 Bridge St., Mifflintown, with the Rev. Marsha Bookhamer, officiating. Interment will follow in the Union Memorial Gardens, Mifflintown.

Viewing will be held from 1:00 p.m., Sunday, October 2, 2011 until the time of service at the funeral home.
